Monday – Thursday Attire:

ABSOLUTELY NO

- Tank tops
- See through blouses
- Bare midriffs
- One-shoulder or off-the-shoulder tops
- Torn or ripped tops
- Exposed cleavage
- Sagging/Bagging Pants

Students at SES **are NOT allowed** to wear:

- Hats (**Unless it is one of our SES beanies, caps or visors**)
- Bandanas
- Visors
- Headbands
- Hairnets
- Dew rags
- Sweatshirt hoods on
- Head Scarves

In an effort to enforce our dress code policy, the staff and administration will be giving Referrals to students who violate the dress code policy. After the Referral, students will be given after school detention. Another violation may result in suspension from school.
