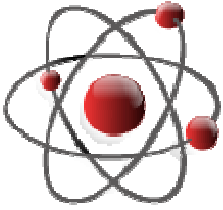

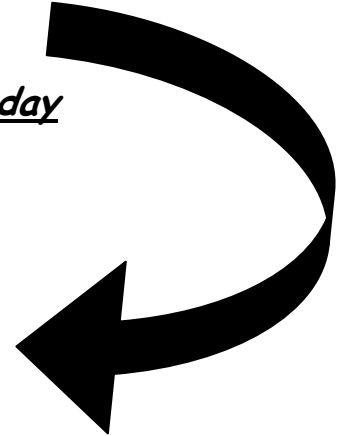


SCIENCE NIGHT

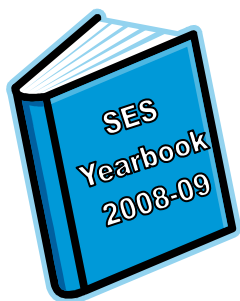

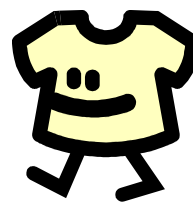


Yearbooks are on sale for \$45.00. If you can't find your order form, they are available in the school office.

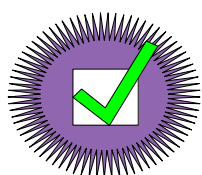
