Smokey Robinson Foundation Scholarship

Award: \$1,500 - \$2,500

Requirements: For graduating seniors of all ethnicities. Awards are based on grades (minimum 2.5 GPA), SAT and ACT scores, evidence of involvement in community service, extra-curricular activities, and a student's statement of purpose. Outstanding Youth in Philanthropy Scholarship

Award: \$1,000

Requirements: Presented to an individual **age 16 to 22 years who has engaged in a variety of philanthropic activities, perhaps with more than one organization, rather than honoring a single achievement. The honoree will be able to direct a \$500 contribution to the charity of his/her choice. This person should demonstrate knowledge, skills, attitude, and values. This is a nomination process; students can be nominated by other students, outside agencies, communities, or school personnel.**

Deadline: May 18, 2008

The 2008 Goldman Sachs Foundation Prizes for Excellence in International Education

Award: Up to 5 winners selected to receive up to \$10,000 each as well as an all-expense paid trip to New York City.

Requirements: For high school students. Students create an in-depth written essay (1,500 words or less) or multimedia feature (6 minutes or less) examining a social or economic issue that has relevance to them in a global context.
