**Asian Pacific State Employees (APSEA) Foundation 25<sup>th</sup> Annual Scholarship Program**

**Award:** \$1,000

**Requirements:** Must be a student residing in the Greater **Sacramento area** who will attend a college/university or vocational school/community college in the 2008-09 academic year. Also offered are scholarships designated for students who best served the Pacific Islander community, those for underserved or low-income students, and those awarded in partnership with Ronald MacDonald House Charities. Applicants must submit a cover letter and a 200-word essay.

**Deadline:** **February 1, 2008**

**Asian Pacific Fund Scholarships**

**Award:** range from \$1,000 to \$5,000

**Requirements:** **Banatao College Scholarship** - Filipino heritage; Engineering, Computer Science, or Physical Science major. **Jack & Jeanette Chu Scholarship** - Asian heritage; accepted to UC Haas School of Business (UCB) or pursuing a teaching career. **Lapiz Family Scholarship** - any ethnic heritage; farm/migrant worker (self or parents); attending a UC campus in the fall (UCD or UCSC preferred). **Maria Elena Yuchengco Memorial Journalism Scholarship** - Filipino heritage; journalism major or career. **Award:** \$1,000

**Requirements:** Must be a graduating senior. Selection is based on scholarship, community/school service activities, letters of recommendation, and a personal essay. Students who demonstrate more potential commitment to their career goals, have a record of volunteer activities, and demonstrate financial need will have preference. Equal opportunity will be given to all applicants and all career choices.

**Deadline:** **March 20, 2008**

**2008 Northern California Cherry Blossom Festival Scholarship**

**Award:** Two \$2,000 awards

**Requirements:** Must be a graduating senior of **Japanese American** descent with a 2.5 GPA and actively involved in his/her local community. Other selection criteria include written essays, academic achievement and personal character. Winners participate in various Festival activities.

**Deadline:** **March 25, 2008**

**Society of Women Engineers Scholarship Program/Sierra Foothills Section**

Award: \$250 to \$1,000

Requirements: Scholarships awarded on the basis of merit to incoming freshman **women** planning to obtain an engineering or computer degree. Must include with the application: high school transcript, letters of recommendation, personal statement and statement of acceptance from the institution indicating acceptance for entry into an undergraduate engineering curriculum.

Deadline: **February 15, 2008**

#### American Slavic Hall Social Club Scholarship

Award: One \$1,000 scholarship

Requirements: For a graduating senior whose ancestry is of the country formerly known as **Yugoslavia**. Must be a U.S. citizen with a minimum GPA of 3.5 who plans to enroll in a full-time college program. Applicant must submit 2 letters of recommendation, a transcript, and a 250-word autobiographical essay. Award selection will be based on grades, extra-curricular activity, test scores, and financial need.

Deadline: **April 1, 2008**

##### The California Association of Collectors Educational Scholarship Foundation

Award: \$1,500 to \$2,500

##### Tuskegee Airmen, Inc. Scholarship

Award: 41 awards of \$1,500; 1 four-year award of \$20,000

Requirements: 3.0 GPA, extra-curricular and community activities, financial need, letters of recommendation, and 2 essays.

Deadline: **February 9, 2008**

##### Ronald McDonald House Charities (RMHC) National Scholarship Program

Award: \$1,000

Requirements: Four scholarship programs offered, depending on heritage. Graduating seniors may apply for one program, must be legal U.S. residents, and must enroll in and attend a 2 or 4-year institution in the fall. Must include transcript, personal statement, recommendation letter, and IRS Form 1040.

Deadline: **February 15, 2008**
