The Thomas M. Eustis Memorial Scholarship

Award: \$1,000

Requirements: For a graduating senior from **C.K. McClatchy who will be attending a **California** campus with a **science or math focus**. Applicants must be well rounded, have a 3.5 GPA, be involved in extra-curricular/community activities, exhibit incentive, cooperative spirit, positive attitude and enthusiasm, and demonstrate financial need. Must include letters of recommendation, transcript, and an essay.**

Deadline: March 28, 2008

The John A. and Charlotte M. Church Memorial Scholarship

Award: \$1,000

Requirements: For a **FEMALE graduating senior from **C.K. McClatchy** (alternates between male and female) with an above average scholarship record who exhibits extracurricular activities and/or community involvement, incentive, leadership qualities, cooperative spirit, positive attitude, and enthusiasm. Must include letters of recommendation, transcript, and essay.**

Deadline: March 28, 2008

The Boyd Citizen-Scholar Award

Award: \$5,000 per year for four years - one award at each of the **SCUSD high schools.**

Requirements: For a graduating senior who exhibits good citizenship, leadership skills, is goal oriented, and demonstrates financial need. Application must include an evaluation form from a member of the high school staff, 2 letters of recommendation from outside of the high school, and a personal statement. **Of significant importance is the student's impact in his/her community and school.**

Deadline: March 28, 2008

The Susan Cherveney Memorial Scholarship

Award: \$500

Requirements: For a graduating senior from a **SCUSD high school who has maintained an average scholarship record. Applicant should exhibit extra-curricular activities/community involvement, excellence in Language Arts and Humanities, cooperative spirit and positive attitude and evidence of financial need. **Special consideration shall be given to applicants who formerly attended Will C. Wood Middle School.****

Deadline: March 28, 2008

The Luella M. Goff Memorial Scholarship

Award: \$900 per year for four years

Requirements: For a graduating **SCUSD** senior who has spent both his/her junior and senior years in a **SCUSD** high school and is eligible for admission to a 4-year **California college** or university or a California community college with qualifications to transfer to obtain his/her Bachelor's degree. Must also include letters of recommendation, student essay, and transcript.

Deadline: **March 28, 2008**

The Grant Bennett Memorial Scholarship

Award: \$1,000

Requirements: **One award** to a student graduating from a **SCUSD** high school who demonstrates financial need, is outstanding academically, exhibits involvement in extra-curricular/community activities. Must include letters of recommendation. Preference may be given to a student who plans to pursue a career in a **business-related** field. **Applicants are required to enroll in a campus of the University of California.**

Deadline: **March 28, 2008**

The Jewel T. O'Connell Scholarship

Award: \$1,000 per year for four years (must carry a minimum of 15 credits per academic period).

Requirements: For a graduating **SCUSD** senior with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Applicant must enroll in a **California institution** and not be a recipient of any other scholarship or grant greater than \$200 per year at the time of the application. **Need** is of primary importance with additional consideration given to the number of children attending college without financial assistance. Must include student essay, transcript, and letters of recommendation.

Deadline: **March 28, 2008**

The Carpenter's Local Union #46 Scholarship

Award: \$1,000

Requirements: For a graduating **SCUSD** senior who will attend a two- or four-year college. Applicants should exhibit a 2.0 GPA, community involvement and volunteer experience, financial need, a positive attitude and enthusiasm. Application must include letters of recommendation, essay, and transcript.

Deadline: **March 28, 2008**

Vietnamese Physician Association of Northern California Scholarship Award

Award: \$1,000

Requirements: For a graduating senior of **Vietnamese descent** with financial hardship. Must have a minimum 3.5 GPA. Application must include a personal essay and demonstration of extra-curricular activities/community involvement, scholastic achievement, awards, honors, hobbies, letters of recommendation, and a copy of parents' most recent income tax return.

Deadline: **April 16, 2008**
