Outstanding Filipino Youth Awards

Award: \$1,000

Requirements: For graduating Filipino seniors who have shown outstanding performance in one or more of the following: academics, arts, athletics, and/or leadership. Must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 and be planning to attend an accredited college or university. Judging criteria include community service, leadership, outstanding academic achievement, ethnic pride, essay, interview, and financial need.

Deadline: April 5, 2008 – Please note the close due date!

California Alarm Association Youth Scholarship Program

Award: Regional award up to \$1,000; State award up to \$1,500; National award up to \$10,000

Requirements: For a graduating senior whose parent or guardian is a member of a law enforcement agency or a full-time paid or volunteer member of a fire department located in California. Awards are based on a combination of academic achievement, test scores, extracurricular activities/community service and an essay about how their parent or guardian helps secure their community.

Deadline: April 11, 2008

M.E.Ch.A. Scholarship

Award: Two \$500 scholarships, for one male and one female

Requirements: For undocumented students planning to pursue higher education with the goal of returning to the community. Must have a 2.5 GPA, write a creative personal statement, provide high school transcript, proof of community service (20 hrs) and college enrollment notification.

Deadline: April 11, 2008

Community NETWORK Scholarship, Sacramento Chapter

Award: A one-year non-renewable award, minimum of \$1,000

Requirements: For African American graduating seniors in recognition for their academic and civic achievement during high school who plan on attending an accredited junior college, trade school, or university. Must have a 3.0 GPA and include two essays, transcript, letter of recommendation.

Deadline: April 15, 2008

Susie Gaines-Mitchell Scholarship

Award: several \$500 scholarships

Requirements: Must be a graduating senior with a minimum 2.5 GPA who resides in Sacramento County and will be entering a 2- or 4-year college, university, technical, or trade school. Applicant should demonstrate school/community involvement and the application must include a 500-word essay. Awards are not based on any income qualifications.

Deadline: April 23, 2008

Tuskegee Airmen George S. "Spanky" Roberts Chapter 2-year College Award

Award: \$250 - \$500

Requirements: For graduating seniors enrolling full-time in one of the Los Rios community colleges (ARC, CRC, SCC, Folsom Lake). Applicant must have a 2.75 GPA.

Deadline: May 1, 2008

Caltrans District 3 Transportation Scholarship

Award: \$500

Requirements: For a graduating senior. The scholarship is based upon the applicant's commitment to a career in transportation, academic record and participation in extra-curricular or community-related activities. Financial need will be a consideration but not a primary factor.

Deadline: May 29, 2008
