Unless otherwise noted, most scholarships are for graduating seniors.

Sacramento Rotary Club Scholarships:

Derek Ian Arnold Scholarship - \$1,504; Robinson Crowell Scholarship - \$2,398; Sacramento Rotary Club Scholarship - \$2,500

Requirements: Will be awarded to outstanding graduating **C.K. McClatchy High School** seniors. Must be in the upper one-third of the class and will attend a four-year college and/or trade school or transfer to a four-year college. Emphasis will be placed on the pursuit of an occupation that will impact the future of the community and encourage the principles of Rotary and the free enterprise system. Must not be the son or daughter of a Rotarian. Selection will be based on scholastic ability, demonstrated leadership ability in school and in the community, financial need, personal statement, essay, letters of recommendation, and interview (for finalists only).

Deadline: March 31, 2008

Elks National Foundation 2008 Most Valuable Student Scholarship Competition

Award: 500 scholarships, ranging from \$1,000 to \$15,000 per year for four years

Requirements: Must be a graduating senior and a U.S. citizen, planning to enroll in an undergraduate 4-year degree program in an accredited U.S. college or university (for the first 2 years of the 4-year program, the student may enroll at a 2-year college). Judging is based on scholarship, leadership (school and community), financial need, a 500-word essay, honors/awards, and two letters of recommendation.

Deadline: Must be filed with the local Elks Lodge by **January 11, 2008**. Do not send application to Elks National Foundation - it will be disqualified.

The Links, Inc. Sacramento Chapter Scholarship Program

Award: up to \$1,000 each

Requirements: For graduating seniors of **African-American** heritage. Three different scholarships: one gives preference to students seeking a career in the performing arts, another for those seeking vocational training, and a third for those seeking a career in an area other than the performing arts or vocational training. Other requirements include a one-page essay, letter of recommendation, and a minimum 2.5 GPA.

Deadline: February 22, 2008

eQuality Scholarship Collaborative

Award: \$5,000

Requirements: Honors graduating seniors for their services to the lesbian/gay/bisexual/transgender community. They must apply to a 2 or 4-year year post-secondary institution. 2-4 page essay required.

Deadline: February 16, 2008

The National Co-op Scholarship Program

Award: 185 merit co-op scholarships of \$6,000 each, renewable

Requirements: Students must apply and be accepted at one of ten National Commission for Cooperative Education Partner Colleges and Universities: Drexel University, Northeastern University, Pace University, Johnson & Wales University, University of Cincinnati, C.W. Post Campus of Long Island University, Kettering University, Rochester Institute of Technology, University of Toledo, and Wentworth Institute of Technology. Cooperative education integrates classroom studies with learning through productive work experiences in a field related to a student's academic or career goals.

Deadline: February 15, 2008

Ronald McDonald House Charities (RMHC) National Scholarship Program

Award: \$1,000

Requirements: **RMHC/ASIA:** applicant must be of Asian-Pacific heritage; **RMHC/Future Achievers:** applicant must be of African American or Black Caribbean heritage; **RMHC/HACER:** applicant must be of Hispanic heritage; **RMHC/Scholars:** all students are eligible to apply regardless of race, color, creed, religion, sexual orientation, gender, disability or national origin. Graduating seniors may apply for **one** scholarship program, must be legal U.S. residents, and must enroll in and attend a 2 or 4-year college or university or vocational school in the fall. Supporting documents include: transcript, personal statement, letter of recommendation, and parent/guardian IRS Form 1040.

Deadline: February 15, 2008

DeVry University Community Scholar Award

Award: \$1,000 per semester, up to 9 semesters

Requirements: One student per high school who has a 2.7 GPA or is among the top 50% in their class and is the first to apply to and be accepted to DeVry, an accredited university located in the Bay Area and Elk Grove, offering associates', bachelors' and masters' degrees in Business, Technology and Management.

Deadline: Must apply to DeVry by **June 1, 2008**. Call Mr. Alan Gulledge, DeVry University Educational Advisor, 916-847-9812.

Sacramento State College of Business Administration Scholarships:

Lance D. Atkinson Memorial Scholarship; President's Scholar Award in Business Administration

Award: Each is a full 4-year scholarship.

Requirements: For academically gifted students who plan to enroll at Sacramento State in the College of Business Administration in the fall of 2008. Applicants must have a minimum 3.5 GPA, qualify as a National Merit Scholar, and demonstrate exemplary leadership skills.

Deadline: February 29, 2008
