The Carl and John F. Otto Memorial Scholarship

Award: \$1,000

Requirements: For graduating **C.K. McClatchy** seniors who must enroll full-time into an accredited two- or four-year college. Applicants should exhibit a minimum **2.0 GPA**, community involvement and volunteer experience, demonstrate financial need and a positive attitude and enthusiasm. Application must also include 2 letters of recommendation, a student essay describing educational and vocational goals, and an official transcript.

Deadline: **March 28, 2008 - Please note the close due date!**

Homer Award, presented by Tower Café

Award: \$1,000

Requirements: For graduating **C.K. McClatchy** seniors. Submit a piece of **written work in essay, poetic, or other form** of the student's choosing (previously written work is OK). Along with the written work, submit your resume to include school activities and your community service involvement. Emphasis for selection will be based on the values of selflessness, generosity, and willingness to serve others.

Deadline: **May 5, 2008**

Filipino-American Community-Wide Scholarship Program

Award: Range from \$300 to \$1,000

Requirements: For graduating seniors of **Filipino-American** descent. Must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Applicants should demonstrate community, school, and work activities and must submit a 250-word essay on the topic "Why do you think the Filipino-American Community needs a FILIPINO COMMUNITY CENTER?" Applicants must provide a brief biography at the time of the in-person interview.

Deadline: **April 10, 2008**

SAFE Credit Union Scholarship

Award: Ten \$1,000 scholarships

Requirements: For local high school college-bound seniors. Applicants must have a 3.0 GPA and demonstrate academic achievement, financial need, and activity/community involvement. The application must include a 250-word personal statement and 4 letters of recommendation.

Deadline: **April 15, 2008**

Sacramento Asian-Pacific Chamber of Commerce Foundation Scholarship

Award: Six \$1,000 scholarships

Requirements: For graduating seniors of **Asian Pacific Islander heritage**, residing in the Greater Sacramento region. Applicant must have a 3.0 GPA and be able to demonstrate support for the Asian Community, school involvement, financial need. Must submit a resume and 2-page personal essay.

Deadline: **April 30, 2008**
