Our college visits have ended. Applications have been submitted. Now it is time to figure out how to meet those college expenses! The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is used by ALL colleges and universities in determining what kind of aid is given to students. This application must also be filed in order to be considered for a Cal Grant. It is recommended that the FAFSA be completed online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. FAFSA on the Web "worksheets" are available in the College Career Center. The first day to file the FAFSA is January 1, 2008. Be sure to attend a Financial Aid Night on Tuesday, December 4th at 7:00 p.m. in the McClatchy Cafeteria. Mary Gill will take you through the application process and answer all of your financial aid questions. Don't miss this important workshop!
