California State PTA Graduating High School Senior Scholarship

Award: \$500 - Last year 145 scholarships were awarded to students in California.

Requirements: Recognizes **volunteer service in the school and community** and does not have a GPA requirement. Applicant must be a California resident, graduating from a high school in California with a PTA/PTSA unit in good standing, and must be a member of his/her high school PTA/PTSA.

Deadline: February 1, 2008

Tuskegee Airmen, Inc. Scholarship

Award: 41 awards of \$1,500; 1 four-year award of \$20,000

Requirements: For graduating seniors with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Other considerations include extra curricular and community activities, financial need, letters of recommendation and two essays. Applicants are **not** required to commit to join any military service or college ROTC unit.

Deadline: February 9, 2008

California Association of Compensatory Education (CACE) Student Scholarship

Award: 2- \$500 scholarships

Requirements: A graduating senior pursuing a college or university education; minimum 2.0 GPA; must demonstrate a potential to succeed, financial need, the ability to meet adversity and be able to express oneself in an autobiography.

Deadline: February 10, 2008

AXA Achievement Community Scholarship

Award: Up to twelve \$2,000 scholarships in our **community**

Requirements: For senior students who set and reach ambitious goals, demonstrate drive, determination and ability to succeed in college and who have respect for self, family and community. Applications are available at www.axa-achievement.com.

Deadline: February 15, 2008

Don and Roy Splawn Charitable Foundation West, Inc. Annual Scholarship Program

Award: up to \$1,000

Requirements: For college-bound seniors with financial hardships. Other criteria include a 3.0 GPA, significant community service, part-time employment and personal challenges. The website for the application process is www.fsrequests.com/splawnhs.

Deadline: February 28, 2008

Italian Catholic Federation Scholarship 2008

Award: \$400 - may be renewable

Requirements: For Catholic graduating seniors of Italian descent who have a minimum 3.2 GPA. Other criteria include financial need, leadership role, faculty recommendation and character reference, extra-curricular activities and a personal statement explaining Italian origin and plans for the future.

Deadline: **March 15, 2008**

California Wine Grape Growers Foundation (CWGGF) Scholarships

Award: At least 6 scholarships: Two provide \$1,000 per year for four years at any U.C. or CSU campus; Four provide \$500 per year for two years at any California community college. Continuation of award is dependent upon satisfactory completion of at least 12 units per semester.

Requirements: Must have a parent or legal guardian who is/was a vineyard employee of a wine grape grower during the 2007 or 2008 season. Other criteria include financial need, demonstrated scholastic ability, community involvement/leadership and /or work history, and a 500-word essay.

Deadline: **April 7, 2008**

Gates Millennium Scholars Program 2008

Award: 1000 awards given. Financial support for the **entire cost** of student's education.

Requirements: For outstanding, low-income **African American, American Indian/Alaska Natives, Asian Pacific Islander American, and Hispanic American students** who demonstrate leadership and meet the Federal Pell Grant eligibility criteria. Application available on-line at www.gmsp.org.

Deadline: Paper submissions: December 31, 2007; **on-line submissions: January 11, 2008.**

Ron Brown Scholar Program

Award: \$10,000 annually for 4 years, to be used at accredited 4-year institutions in the U.S.

Requirements: For **African-American** seniors who demonstrate academic achievement, leadership and community service, financial need and seek to become leaders in a wide spectrum of professions.

Deadline: **January 9, 2008**

Elks National Foundation 2008 Most Valuable Student Scholarship Competition

Award: 500 awards, ranging from \$1,000 to \$15,000 per year for four years

Requirements: For seniors planning to enroll in a 4-year degree program (or transfer from a 2-year college). Criteria include scholarship, leadership, financial need, honors/awards, essay, recommendations.

Deadline: Must be filed with the **local Elks Lodge by January 11, 2008.**
