The Horatio Alger Scholarship Program

Award: Range in value from \$1,000 to \$20,000

Requirements: For seniors who have demonstrated integrity, perseverance in overcoming adversity, strength of character, financial need, a good academic record (minimum 2.0 GPA), commitment to pursue a college education, and a desire to contribute to society.

Deadline: **October 30, 2007.** Must submit application online at www.horatioalger.org/scholarships and must mail one letter of support.

Coca-Cola Scholars Program

Award: 50 four-year \$20,000 scholarships and 200 four-year \$4,000 scholarships

Requirements: Must be a well-rounded senior. The scholarship rewards leadership and excellence as exemplified through academic achievement (3.0 GPA) and extracurricular activities, including commitment to community service.

Deadline: **October 31, 2007.** The application is available on-line at www.coca-colascholars.org.

Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc. Scholarship

Award: Varies from year to year; minimum of \$500; multiple awards

Requirements: For **African American** seniors attending school in Sacramento Placer, Yolo, and El Dorado counties. Selection criteria include academics, financial necessity, extracurricular activities, character, citizenship, and career objective. Also required: a personal statement, official transcript and two letters of recommendation.

Deadline: **November 16, 2007**

Sacramento Legal Secretaries Association Scholarship Program

Award: not stated

Requirements: For seniors who successfully completed business courses in high school and desire to seek a career/position in the legal field, including legal secretary, receptionist, legal assistant, paralegal, or court reporter. Other criteria include applicant's financial need, personal characteristics, aspirations, and goals.

Deadline: **January 31, 2008**

Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Scholarship Fund

Award: \$500

Requirements: For high school seniors who plan to attend college. Applicants are required to write a one to five page essay, be active in the community, and provide two references. Selection will be based on character and citizenship.

Deadline: **November 21, 2007**. The MLK Award Dinner will be held on January 21, 2008 in Davis, Ca.

Specific College Awards

Emory University, Emory Scholars Program and Goizueta Scholars Program (Business School)

Two-thirds tuition to full-tuition, room, board and fees for four years at Emory University, Atlanta, Georgia. Students must have outstanding records of academic achievement, personal qualities, and have made significant contributions to their class, school, and community.

Deadline: Must be submitted with Emory application of Admission by **November 1, 2007**.

University of Connecticut Scholars Programs

New England's BEST Public University, as reported in U.S .News & World Report, America's Best Colleges 2008. A series of renewable scholarships (one-half to full tuition) for high school seniors with a record of high academic achievement and leadership. Priority consideration will be given to students who apply for admission by **December 1, 2007**.

Seattle University, The Sullivan Leadership Award

A four-year full scholarship supporting students committed to service and leadership, academic excellence, community involvement, social justice, and international awareness.

Deadline: Must be submitted with application for admission to the University by **November 15, 2007**.

CSU Chico President's Scholars Competition

Award: 10 -\$12,000 awards, \$3,000 per year for 4 years

Requirements: Must be enrolling at CSU Chico as a freshman in the fall 2008 semester. Based on merit, candidate's communication, problem solving, and critical thinking skills. Other criteria include extracurricular activities, leadership and service roles.

Deadline: Must apply for admission during the **October or November 2007 initial filing period**. The scholarship Competition Day is February 23, 2008.
