Guest presentation: CKM Web Site

Jason Elkins and Austin Joyce presented information concerning the CKM web site. A new site is being designed by the students with the oversight of Mr. Elkins. The site should be cleaner and more easily navigated. Mr. Elkins will be taking three weeks of training using the Dream Weaver software. Teacher pages need to be redesigned. There will be better links for club web sites, staff information, RT schedules and so on. At this time Mr. Elkins has what he needs to get the web site moving. There was discussion concerning the posting of the CKM PTSA minutes on the web site. This will also be addressed. The goal for the completed, newly designed web page is April.

Principal's Report: Academics

Cynthia Clark passed out packets containing information about the WASC School Profile Data. Noted items:

\*Average school GPA is 2.52

\*12% of the school population is receiving an "F"

\*11.8% of the school population is receiving a "D"

\*West Campus does not take all students who apply due to Open Enrollment

- \*2007 graduating class had a National Merit Scholar and 10-11 Commended Scholars
- \*No Child Left Behind requires that students meet increased bench mark scores of 10% a year until 2014.
- \*Class sizes in math have been reduced to help students increase their California Standards Test scores
- \*Bench mark tests are given quarterly to measure students' academic growth
- \*Standards are posted in the classrooms
- \*Ms. Clark is aware of where the problems lie within the teaching staff and is currently addressing the issue

#### Grad Night Report:

Kirstie Wilson discussed the Carnival theme of the evening. Volunteers are needed. The student ticket price is \$50. The Grad Night committee raises enough money for cover the additional \$100/student that it really costs to put on the event. Grad Night funding will be discussed as an action item at the March PTSA meeting.
