- You may pick up your schedule any time during your “last name” scheduled time slot. Lines are typically longer at the beginning of each session.
- **In order to obtain a schedule, each student must have the following paperwork completed, signed and with them to turn in. All required forms are included in this document for you to print. Schedules can not be obtained without this paperwork.**
 - **COMPLETED AND SIGNED EMERGENCY CARD**
 - **COMPLETED AND SIGNED TEXTBOOK POLICY FORM**
 - **PAYMENT TO CLEAR ANY OUTSTANDING FINANCIAL DEBTS (if applicable)**
- If a student is not available to pick up their schedule during the pick-up days designated above, someone else may pick up the schedule as long as they bring the completed and signed paperwork outlined above. After presenting these items, the designee may pick up your schedule and purchase items for you.

CLASS SCHEDULE CHANGE POLICY

- Student has taken a course during the summer requiring a schedule change.
- Student needs a level change, i.e., should be in Algebra, but placed in Geometry.
- Student has an incomplete schedule.

After you pick up your schedule, if you feel you need to make a Schedule change, **AND YOU MEET THE SCHEDULE CHANGE REQUIREMENTS** (as outlined above) you must fill out a Schedule Change Request form at schedule pick-up. Counselors will be available at Hot August Tracks to review your request and give you a reply by the first day of school on September 8, 2009.

- **MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 8, 2009, IS THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL FOR 2009-2010.**
School begins at 8:00 A.M.

- **SCHOOL PICTURES:** Lifetouch Photographers will mail picture information and packets directly to registered students this summer. **Please bring the completed packet and payment with you to your appointed schedule pick-up date. School pictures and yearbook photos will be taken for all undergrads at this time. Please dress appropriately for the yearbook photo. Student body ID pictures will also be taken for all students. Student ID cards are mandatory for textbook and library book check-out, all financial transactions, student dances and activities, and athletic events.** Please make every effort to attend your schedule pick-up date and have your picture taken. If you are not able to attend on your scheduled day and time, you may come on any of the other scheduled days to have your picture taken. Lifetouch photographers will only be available on campus during the schedule pick-up dates and times. If you cannot make any of these dates, the picture make up day will be scheduled during the first two weeks of school.

- **SENIOR YEARBOOK PHOTOS** will be taken at Prestige Portraits. It is not mandatory to purchase your senior portraits through Prestige Portraits, but you must have your yearbook photo taken by them to be included in the school yearbook. There is no sitting fee if the student has their portrait taken and allows Prestige Portraits to choose the pose that is put in the yearbook. If the student wants to choose the pose that is put in the yearbook, there is a \$15 sitting fee. This summer, Prestige Portraits will be mailing seniors an information packet about scheduling an appointment at their studio located at 7916 Alta Sunrise Drive, Citrus Heights, 95610. SCUSD Textbook Policy

Parents: Please sign and return this form to Hot August Tracks.
Class schedule, textbooks and supplies will not be issued until turned in.

1. It is the student's responsibility to examine each textbook carefully and report any damage to the textbook clerk within two weeks of issue. After two weeks students and/or parents will be held responsible for any damage.
2. If a student loses or fails to turn in a textbook, the parent is charged for the replacement cost of the book (\$45.00 - \$135.00).
3. There is a \$10.00 fee if a student removes or vandalizes a barcode on a textbook.
4. A student and/or parent is charged \$1.00 a page for writing, scratching, tearing or in any way defacing a textbook, not to exceed the cost of replacing the text (SCUSD will repair the book).
5. A fee of \$10.00 is charged for breaking the binding of a book.
6. If pages are missing from a text, the cost of replacing the text (approximately \$45.00-135.00 per book) is charged.
7. A student has the responsibility to return text books to the textbook room on the day of the final exam.
8. Upon graduation/departure, if a student has any outstanding textbooks or other debts, he/she will not receive their grades, transcripts or diploma until all debts are cleared. Ed Code 48904 (2) (b).
9. A student's participation in graduation ceremonies/senior activities will depend on a clear debt status as stated in the Rosemont Handbook.
10. If a text book is damaged, all repairs are made by district staff only.
